Crisis Line Volunteer Requirements

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must have at least a 12th grade education
- Must NOT have a criminal record
- Must be willing to submit to a background check
- Must complete the Volunteer Application complete with two (2) references and signed agreement
- Must be dependable
- Must complete QPR training prior to taking a call shift
- Must complete a total of 10 hours of training per year
- Must be able to put personal agendas aside (i.e. religious views, political views, etc)
- Must be able to express empathy
- Must attend quarterly volunteer meetings
- Must commit to one (1) shift a week for six (6) months
- Must complete Crisis Line Call Log Sheets weekly and return to Crisis Line Coordinator
- HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** that volunteers have access to a computer and email
